There are a total of four positions available for six month terms. The following recognized trades will be supported:

As part of the Maintenance Department, the Welder works as part of the team to maintain and fabricate site equipment so that the mill operates in an efficient and safe mechanical condition.

Responsibilities:

- Welding according to pre-set parameters using MIG, ARC and TIG welding processes
- Read and understand production drawings, blueprints, work orders and other written instructions
- Work with site personnel to ensure continuous improvements on work cells and hitting quotas
- Assist in the development of repair estimates
- Conduct technical inspections, repairs, modifications and retrofits
- Monitor parts usage and report on any material issues
- Plan maintenance in conjunction with Supply Chain and Operations personnel
- Understand and follow all safe work practices and procedures
- Maintain a high level of housekeeping standards
- Provide mechanical support if required for Industrial Mechanic's
