- Up to twenty six students enrolled in each cohort who learn together and support each other through the program

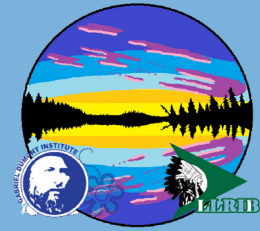
